School of Medicine

During the 2017-2018 academic year, thirty-four full-time faculty files were reviewed by the Office of Academic Affairs in the following categories (see Table 2): fourteen in the tenure track, six in the research track, and fourteen in the clinical track. The overall approval rate was 97%. There was 100% concurrence between the recommendations of the Personnel & Honors Committees and the Provost. This report does not reflect appointment or track-change data for Assistant Professors.
